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Learning From Multi-Agency Audits

Throughout the year a combination of Deep Dives and Light Touch audits are carried out as part of the GSCB rolling programme of Quality Assurance, which links with our Learning and Improvement Framework.

All audits include checking that children and young people have their views and opinions heard and their experiences are understood by the professionals working with them. The voice of service users is key to “good” LSCB monitoring and challenging the effectiveness of local safeguarding arrangements, and assessing what difference has been made.

As part of our continued website design and development, we have brought this learning together into one place to enable practitioners working with children and their families to consider the key findings and ‘Top Tips’ for practice. Learning from multi-agency audits is also incorporated into all inter-agency GSCB training and shared with our partner organisations for inclusion in single-agency training and wider dissemination across the children and families workforce.
