Prevent Referral Pathway and Guidance

Prevent is part of the Government's strategy to stop people becoming involved in violent extremism or supporting terrorism. Prevent is about ensuring that vulnerable children and adults receive support before their vulnerabilities are exploited by those who want to groom them into becoming involved in terrorism or supporting terrorism.

Prevent is a safeguarding issue and it is really important that all professionals are able to identify concerns and take appropriate action 'Notice, Check and Share'. If you believe that someone is vulnerable to being exploited or radicalised then you need to follow your organisation's safeguarding procedures and visit the GSCB website via the link below for details of the Prevent process map and guidance for how to make a referral for a person who is under the age of 18.
